

Some of our profits from our commercial activity as a landlord and award-winning events venue are invested by the charitable trust into projects, events and initiatives which support the growth of science, technology, engineering, and maths (STEM) and education in the West Midlands.

Millennium Point Charitable Trust provides funding annually to not-for-profit organisations, schools, and colleges across the West Midlands Combined Authority area. Applicants can apply for up to £20,000 to fund their STEM-related project subject to meeting the eligibility criteria and demonstrating a measurable impact in STEM education.

On average, annually we provide £385.7K a year to schools for projects. To date, we have provided £3.4m in grant funding to over 160 schools and not-for-profit organisations in the region.

We have seen the rewarding outcome of past projects such as an Automatic Weather Station, Sensational Science interactive workshops and teaching code to bring robots to life with the Aston Villa Foundation.

Annually, we provide funding for Scholarships for an undergraduate degree, in partnership with Birmingham City University. The Scholarship programme is aimed at students who are looking to start careers in industries for the Built Environment, Computing, Digital Technology and Engineering.

There are over 20 courses to choose from. Previous winners have included 37-year-old, mother of 5, Asima, who went on to study Planning, and Sagal who has since gone on to graduate with a First-Class Honours degree in Civil Engineering, More recently, Hatem, who was a student studying an Extended Diploma in IT (Network and Security) is now achieving his dream of studying Computer Science at University.

ACTIVITIES

Being an award-winning venue in the middle of Birmingham has allowed us to support other charities and give them the space to host their events as well as our own.

To celebrate the Commonwealth Games, Millennium Point welcomed more than 1,000 school children from 28 schools across the region. They took part in a range of activities, workshops, and talks delivered by a host of organisations and personalities from the world of sport and science.

Previously, we hosted St Basils BIG Sleepout, with the aim to raise funds to help end youth homelessness. Approximately 300 people took part, including Millennium Point's CEO, Abbie Vlahakis. St Basils managed to raise £30,213 which was a fantastic achievement! Every £5 raised will help house an at-risk youth for just one night, this means that St Basils can continue their life changing work.

We have also hosted the Fire & Ice Walk for best-loved charities, Acorns Children's Hospice and LoveBrum with the aim to raise money. The atmosphere in the building was amazing inside and out with activities such as a DJ, face painting, balloon modelling and a circus workshop that was enjoyed by all that participated. The Millennium Point team also took part and braved the Ice Walk to help raise further funds for the charities. From this event their Just Giving page raised an amazing £25,222!











ROUNDTABLE

The Millennium Point Charitable Trust has formed a STEM Roundtable where schools. universities and STEM learning providers work together to improve STEM education and STEM as a career choice within the West Midlands. They are currently working on programmes that support teacher training and development.
